ADMISSION INTO 2021/2022 NAPTIN GRADUATE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (NGSDP)

The National Power Training Institute of Nigeria (NAPTIN) was established in 2009 as an agency of the Federal Government of Nigeria, operating under the aegis of the Federal Ministry of Power with a primary purpose of providing training for power sector personnel and coordinating training activities in the sector through its Headquarters in Abuja and Eight Regional Training Centres across the six geo-political zones of the country.

Having identified the skills gap for graduate engineers, aspiring entrepreneurs and training needs in the power sector companies, NAPTIN designed a training programme to cut across the electricity value chain (Power Generation, Transmission, Distribution and Renewable Energy) including Health, Safety and Environment (HSE 1,2&3), Solar Photovoltaic Installation, Leadership and Management training all encompassed in the 2021/2022 NAPTIN Graduate Skills Development Programme (NGSDP).

This programme will equip qualified Graduates of Higher Institutions with the necessary knowledge, and requisite skills needed to build a career in the Power Sector as an entrepreneur or working professional. At the end of each classroom session, participants will be exposed to an intense hands-on practical session (Field Experience) at power utilities across the country's electricity value chain (Generation, Transmission and Distribution), they shall maintenance and operations of power partake in components (under supervision), become certified professionals in Solar Photovoltaic Installation (SPVI), Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) and Leadership and Management (L & M).

Interested individuals, corporate organisations/multinationals who intend to sponsor, in-line with Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), government functionaries who also wish to take advantage of the few slots allocated in-line with national representation to empower their indigenes, that we are now processing applications for admission into the 2021/2022 NGSDP.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2021/2022 NAPTIN GRADUATE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (NGSDP)

A graduate from a recognized University/Polytechnic or persons with qualification adjudged to a first degree (B.Sc. or HND) in Electrical/Electronic and Mechanical Engineering must have completed their National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) programme may be admitted into the one year skills development and upgrade programme.

COURSE DURATION

The programme will take a maximum duration of 12 months (1 year) as follows: 3 months classroom sessions and 9 months of hands-on field practicals. This implies that admitted trainees will be posted to power companies for hands-on field experience under strict supervision.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is ¥750,000.00, which covers Tuition Fee, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), Training Materials, Tea Snack and Lunch during classroom sessions, Administrative Charges and Accessories.

Applicants should be informed that the course fee does not include accommodation, transportation or monthly stipend. At the end of the training, participants shall be awarded certificates graded according to their level of performance (Pass or Merit).
